

Adobe Premiere Elements – Part II

Creating a DVD of Clips for Class

The process of creating a quick and dirty DVD of clips for your class is identical to the procedures we just followed for the Gorée movie. Briefly, here's what you need to do:

1. Capture your clips.
2. Launch Premiere Elements. Select "Start a new project."
3. Import your media into the media window.
4. Drag your clips onto the timeline. You can butt them up against each other as we did in our movie or you can leave some blank space between them. If you leave space, this space will appear as a black screen if you play the DVD straight through from start to finish.
5. Place a DVD marker at the beginning of each clip; name it as you wish the name to appear in the scene selection menu.
6. Click the DVD button; edit any titles or thumbnails you wish. Preview the DVD, then burn it.
